## DARING TO TELL

Psalm 6:10 I Thessalonians 2:1-8

To Whom Do We Dare Tell the Good Message? Variety of Persons, Places, Opportunities...

Aware.. Enemies...Opposers...Detractors—Skeptics/Scoffers/Doubters

The Psalmist's Confidence—Enemies Overwhelmed/Shamed

How much will we risk for the sake of the Gospel of Jesus Christ?

Will We Dare to Tell, Dare to Live the Gospel? Paul's Situation: Suffered-Treated Outrageously...And Yet...Emboldened—By God to speak the Good News...

Key: Speak As Ones Approved By God to be Entrusted With the Gospel!

Today: too Familiar? Lose its Luster...Joy Fades, as does Amazement at its riches?

Remember: We are Not Pleasing People...We are Pleasing God

When we Please People: Conditional, Circumstantial, Limited...People Change

When We Please God: We search the scriptures for Never-Changing Truth; We Seek to be Obedient out of Love...because God first loved us...God Never Changes

No Flattery No Put On No Mask of Cover up

The Gospel is Not Ours to Keep To Ourselves Personally

The Gospel is Not Ours to Keep Only Among the Body

The Gospel is Ours To Share in Every Way God Allows us to do it.
