Chris Todd is a trauma therapist, church planter, missionary in the Middle East, friend to Muslims, and pastor. Chris and his wife, Kim, took their four children from Marshall County, Alabama to Beirut, Lebanon as missionaries in January, 2012.

They worked among Syrian refugees in Burj Hammoud as church planters before moving to Tyre, Lebanon in April 2013 to partner in a second church planting work. Chris and Kim now serve with the National Evangelical Synod of Syria and Lebanon.

Over the last five years they have opened schools for Syrian refugee children as well as women’s literacy and health classes inside refugee camps near Tyre, Lebanon. They now have church planting works in southern Lebanon, as well as the Egyptian cities of Asyut and Luxor. Their newest ministry initiative is an EMDR-based trauma therapy program for war refugees suffering from anxiety, depression, and PTSD.

Words of Isa, Inc. is a 501c3 charitable organization incorporated in the state of Alabama and operating in the Middle East. The goal is to share the message of Jesus Christ among Muslims and to plant churches of faithful disciples.
