WHO WANTS TO BE HOLY? Exodus 19:10-11 Hebrews 12:14-15

John Wesley...The Mission of the people called Methodist:
"To reform the nation and, in particular, the Church, to spread
scriptural holiness over the land." Do we want to be holy?
If so, it means we will; 1)Be Done with sin...2)Be Becoming
More Complete in the Love of God...CONSECRATED...

Bold Hebrews Statement: "Make Every Effort"...at Peace with
others. "Be Holy!" Without holiness we will not see the Lord.
John Wesley...Grand Depositum...The major contribution God
has entrusted to the people called Methodist...Scriptural
Doctrine of ENTIRE SANCTIFICATION...Christian Perfection...
I Thess. 4:3: "For this is the will of God, your sanctification."
In the Christian life Two Key Works God does...

1-Justification-forgiving the sin debt. New Birth, being
Born again means an inward change. Jesus stands in front of
a repentant sinner and God the Father sees the righteousness
of Jesus Christ and forgives the sinner because of Christ's
righteousness...

2-Sanctification-the Process of growing in holiness, of
becoming more like Jesus. It is growth in loving God and
loving others. It is both gradual and instantaneous. We can
always give ourselves more in submission to the Holy Spirit.
