

What The Bible Says About: LIFE IN THE SPIRIT... Psalm 51:10-11 Romans 14:17

The Prayer...Create in me a clean heart...God has to do it. God has to Renew our spirits. Thought: Let Me Be Present With You, Lord. The Holy Spirit helps us.

Salvation comes by Grace Through Faith in Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit draws us to Christ. He convicts us then shows us the way out of sin and the unavoidable bondage it affords. What is Life in the Spirit? "The Spirit-filled life is the Christ-directed life by which Christ lives His life in and through us in the power of the Holy Spirit." It is a continual submission of our whole being to the Spirit of Christ. And it is also, "an active, continuous seeking to be filled on our part. The Holy Spirit's influence increases the more we obey and give Him freedom to work. The original term for "to be filled" means overflowing and having more than enough. The only way we can be for Jesus completely is to be filled with His Spirit. We can pray each morning for a fresh infilling. When we do, He fills us.

In his book Just Like Jesus, Max Lucado mentions the crowning attribute of Christ was: "HIS HEART WAS SPIRITUAL." His thoughts were in union with his intimate relationship with the Father. His first recorded sermon begins with "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me." (Luke 4:18) He was led by the Spirit and led by the Holy Spirit. (Matt. 4:1; Luke 4:1) He returned from the desert of testing "in the power of the Holy Spirit." (Luke 4:14)

REGARDING THE HOLY SPIRIT:

1-The Power-Jesus promised it in Acts 1:8...The Power to Overcome the enemy. The Power to Witness wherever believers find themselves. The Power to Bear Any Injustice because of the Gospel. (Phil. 4:13)

2-The Engagement-We engage the Holy Spirit first and then we Engage the world for Jesus Christ. VISION of the Disciples prior to meeting Jesus. Think of what he told them at the end of Matthew's gospel to Go Make Disciples of all Nations. (Matt. 28:19) They were Scattered. Acts 8:1, the church was scattered throughout Judea and Samaria. Verse 4 reads: ""Those who had been scattered preached the word wherever they went." They Engaged the world.

3-The Joy-Romans 14:17-"For the kingdom of God is not a matter or eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit." How marvelous Life in the Spirit is. In Acts 13, we read how persecution arose against Paul and Barnabas. They were expelled from the region. As they left, shaking dust off their feet, Verse 52 reads: "And the disciples were filled with Joy and with the Holy Spirit." To the Thessalonian believers, Paul wrote how the gospel went to them "not simply with words but also with power, with the Holy Spirit and deep conviction. (I Thess. 1:5) In verse 6 he mentions how they "welcomed the message in the midst of severe suffering with the Joy given by the Holy Spirit." Not your typical worldly cheer or happiness. It is a Joy born of something deeper than circumstances and bigger than our world understanding. Joy in the Holy Spirit.

-The Spirit was involved in Creation. (Gen. 1:2) -The Spirit Moved among God's Faithful Servants under the Old Covenant. Joshua (Num. 27:18), Gideon (Judges 6:34). -The Spirit Inspired Holiness in Old Testament believers. (Ps. 143:10) -The Spirit Gave Birth to the Church by Descending from Heaven on the Day of Pentecost. (Acts 2) -The Spirit Continues to Give Life Today.... Will We Live Spirit-filled Lives?
