

# The 7 Churches of Revelation...FORSAKEN LOVE-Ephesus Jeremiah 17:13 Revelation 2:1-7

God's Displeasure-When His Children Forsake His Way...The Prophet-"Put to Shame;" "Written in the Dust;" for forsaking The Lord: The Spring of Living Water...

In The Spirit on the Lord's Day...John saw a Vision...PATMOS... Encountered the Living and Exalted Christ...7 Lampstands, 7 Stars in his right hand.

EPHESUS: -Leading Roman City...250,000-500,000 residents.
-Major Seaport -Center of Worship for a mother goddess.
Artemis-Greeks Diana-Romans. An Abounding Pagan influence was there.

The Risen Exalted Christ...Commendation, Correction, or Confrontation.

-Commended for-Patient Endurance (Revel. 2:3)-Hard Work, Perseverance, Not Tolerating wicked pretenders...Endured Hardships for his Name, Did Not Wear Out. They Hated the practices of the Nicolaitans.

-Correction: (2:4) "YOU HAVE FORSAKEN THE LOVE YOU HAD AT FIRST." This is described as "Poor Stewardship of Love." 2-Fold Charge 1) Consider How Far You Have Fallen. 2) Repent-turn 180 degrees and go in the right direction. The Evidence would be that they again would, "DO The Things They DID at first."

WARNING: Failure to Repent would mean...Removal of the Lampstand=They would Cease To Be A Church.

OUR CHALLENGE-Painful and Honest Examination-How is Our Stewardship of the Love of God? If we have Left, it is now time to Return. Only He can restore to our rightful place...

What Then? Victory Comes Through our complete Association with Him. Those who are Victorious-Eat From the Tree of Life in the Paradise of God...

Do We Dear Ones, Have Ears to Hear. In the Jewish context, "to hear" is synonymous with "to obey." Let Us Commit to HEAR and OBEY!
