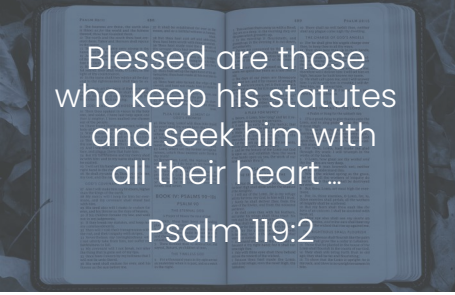

Pergamum...Danger for Christ Followers:

- 1) Center of worship for every major deity,
- 2) Idolatry and Sexual Immorality* were prominent
- 3) These unrighteous practices infiltrated the Church

Compromised...Mixing of Christ-allegiance with participation in idolatrous acts.

What We Learn:

- A- The Ease with which we can become double-minded.
- B- The Uneasy Feeling of knowing we are Living Opposed to the Lord.
- C- Repentance is the Answer to the Question of Compromising.
- D- A Reward is Offered to those who Overcome.
