Laodicea: Wealthy Town...Affluence-Less Need for God

From: -The Amen -The Faithful and True Witness -Ruler of God's creation.

- Problem: Lukewarm Status-Accommodation with Culture- "It did not stand out against the culture it lived in."
- Verdict: About to Be Vomited Out.
- Their Perspective: Acknowledged Wealth, No Need. Christ's Perspective: Wretched Poor, Pitiful, Poor, Blind, and Naked.
- The Counsel: Christ's Gold-juxtaposed to all of theirs. White Clothes to cover nakedness. Eye Salve resulting in sight. Christ Promised Rebuke and Discipline to those he loves.
- The Charge-Repent=To Turn From and begin a Radical Restructuring of one's perspectives and values.
- The Response of Christ: Stand at the door and knocks... Desiring-
 - It to be Opened
 - He can come in
 - Reveal his Presence, Power, and Provision.
