A DIFFERENT GLORIFICATION

Psalm 57:11 John 12:23-26


God's Glory over all the earth...He is exalted, esteemed most high. Hebrew word Kabod which denotes: Importance, Weighty, Heaviness/Honor Majesty and Respect...

JESUS and new Glorification...Greek word Doxa...Radiance, Splendor of God's holy character....Usually-Greatness, Renown, Notoriety.

Jesus introduces a Different Sense of Glorification:

- From Death, Comes Life...a seed in the ground. Death with a Purpose, with a Plan that leads to life....An innocent one dies...goes into the ground, yet springs forth with life. Jesus' Glorification in death is the seed which produces Eternal Life.
- Love This Life Too Much...Cling to the things the world values, Grasp and holding to possessions = Losing the deeper Life.
- Hate Your Life Here-Despise, Spurn the Natural way of the world = Keeping Life for Eternity.
